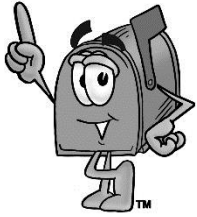
It is a joy to serve you and we trust God's richest blessings for you always and in all ways!

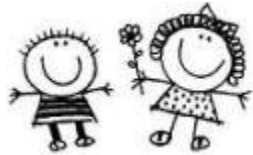
