


**Bibles for Panama:** The leaders of the Chiricana Baptist Association, who the Goshen Associate has worked with over the last 5 years, has an opportunity to go into public and private schools to share what the Bible means to them, give their testimonies, share their faith and hand out Bibles. How can Oakland help in spreading the gospel? A case of Bibles costs \$73. To date, we have raised \$580 which is almost 8 cases of Bibles. We have collected \$235.50 in donations, \$73 from CCSM Committee, and raised \$271.50 through the bake sale held during consignment. Thanks to everyone who baked items for us.
